Budget increase due to Census 2010 figures recently released - the overall Region 10 budget has a decrease but the RSU has an increased assessment based on the Census figures for all three towns.

Article 6

Tuition - \$38,126

We will no longer pay tuition to Region 10 for Durham students attending Brunswick High School and Maine Region 10 because they are now included in the RSU assessment.

- Professional Development Flex Time additional time for training and professional work
- Student Technology PK-6
- Enrichment/Gifted and Talented support (positions)
- Intervention Supports for Students (instructional, behavioral, and programmatic)
- Continued Support for Appropriate Class Size
- Beautification/Improvement of our Schools and Grounds
