

**Internet Safety and Acceptable Use  
MLTI iPad Tablet Use Procedures  
Freeport Middle School**

The Apple iPad tablet is being provided to your child as part of the Maine Technology Learning Initiative (MLTI) instituted by the State of Maine. This initiative provides one-to-one technology device access for all seventh and eighth grade public school students and teachers in the entire state. In addition, RSU 5 supports one-to-one tablet access for all sixth graders in the district. The intent of this initiative is to provide student access to this technology at home as well as at school. In order for this to happen, the following guidelines have been developed and adopted.

**Guidelines:**

In order to use an iPad tablet, parents and students must have attended a Family Orientation meeting offered by the school.

It is the responsibility of the student and parents to know the FMS tablet expectations on the back of this document. Expectations are reviewed when students receive the tablet and when parents attend the mandatory orientation session.

The tablet issued to each student is an educational tool. Students should have no expectations of privacy in their use of the tablet.
